# Annual Report of Make a Difference Nepal (April 2023 – March 2024) (Nepali Year 2080)

## ABOUT THE ORGANIZATION

- **June 30, 2023** — Healthy Morning Routines
- **March 24, 2024** — Keeping Our Surroundings Clean

The sessions were interactive and designed to encourage students to think about their responsibilities toward themselves, their community, and their environment. Students actively participated in discussions and activities, demonstrating enthusiasm and curiosity about the topics. Teachers also appreciated the relevance of these sessions in supporting students' overall development beyond academic learning.
